From 2002 to 2008, A.I.S. Inc. (AIS) completed marine species surveys for Iroquois Pipeline Operating Company during a natural gas pipeline expansion and remediation in Long Island Sound. The project included both shipboard observation and land based coordination. AIS was contracted to plan, design and develop the survey methodology and data forms in accordance with the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) standards.



Prior to the commencement of in-water work, AIS staff developed a curriculum to be implemented during a worker training program. The training program was administered by AIS staff and presented the survey protocol, identification characteristics of sensitive marine species, and mitigation measures. AIS managed the survey and deployment of the staff assigned to this project. NMFS approved the Protected Species Observers responsible for surveying the construction area for the presence of federally listed and endangered marine species, monitoring radio broadcasts for information concerning marine mammals, and recording and reporting all sightings. AIS provided detailed briefings to representatives of Iroquois Pipeline, which were then incorporated into a final project report.
