In 2014, A.I.S., Inc. (AIS) was contracted by ASL Environmental Sciences to provide protected species monitoring services during installation and maintenance of moored scientific instruments that measured ice draft, ice velocity, and current profiles. The three year project, funded by Conoco Phillips Alaska Inc., consisted of one spring and one fall cruise each year. Instruments were deployed and recovered at three sites located in Cook Inlet, near the village of Nikiski, Alaska. AIS provided experienced protected species observers to monitor for the presence of marine mammals and other species of interest while transiting to and from the project site and during the operational installation and removal of this equipment. In addition to sighting information, the AIS team collected environmental data.
